Hi Jan,

Thank you so much for your help during class today. I'm sure now the students feel a little easier about their tasks during the OH&S unit. This has been a really great opportunity for me to learn about using the Learning Place. I can see how useful the collaboration tools can be. You have prepared some wonderful learning materials for the students and given me some excellent ideas for how I can integrate ICT. Even the slower students have support and are engaged.

I forget to ask you today, apparently I am teaching a Year 10 'BIC' class for semester 2. Greg said he wanted me to teach an Introduction to Accounting subject but has named the class 10BIC. I spoke to Jelena Edhouse (HOD, Business) today and she suggested that I teach 1 term of BIC and 1 term of Introduction to Accounting. I am fine with this but wonder how you want me to structure the term of BIC. I have around 8 new students who I believe may not have had much computing experience and almost all the students I currently have completing BIC. Do you want me to begin teaching Cert II in BIC for the original students - if so, do you have a course structure about where you want me to start? What about the students who haven't completed Cert I, do you want me to start them from the beginning? I'll have another chat with Greg tomorrow to confirm as much as I can, but your suggestions would be appreciated.
